God went before us and met all of our needs along the way. We're now settled in to our new home and are planning to be in Nickel Mines until May 2010 when we will return to Mongolia.

So far we have had the opportunity to share in five churches about our time in Mongolia. It is encouraging to see some of you at those times and share more in detail about what we are involved in. We are planning a trip to the Atlanta-area in mid-February for a missions conference and would enjoy seeing many of you who live in the area at

that time. Our schedule is pretty open in 2010, so if you have a Sunday School class or home group in the Lancaster area that we could share in, please contact us.

Barb continues to homeschool the children and takes them to a bi-weekly co-op with other homeschool children. They've quickly made friends with some of the students and look forward to the co-op Tuesdays. We have also had many opportunities to see both our parents, who live locally, and that is always a blessing. I have been helping my mother to prepare for her move to assisted living in December.

We continue to keep in touch with our teammates, the Phillips, back in Tosontsengel and are encouraged by some recent opportunities to teach the Bible to some people who have previously shown interest during the past two years.
