DEAR FRIENDS,

As I write this we are planning to leave for Ulaanbaatar on the 14th of January. We are renting a van and will be traveling two days to the capital. It seemed to fit everyone's schedule best for us to go at this time and volunteer again at the Bible Society of Mongolia (BSM). This time around I will be helping to upgrade their computer network and to resolve several outstanding problems. In addition I will help them to transition to some new software they will be using for future translation and layout work. Our plan is to be there until sometime in May and then return to Tosontsengel for four months before we come to the states for our furlough. For our family this has been the longest stretch of time that we've been in Mongolia, we arrived January 30th, 2006.

We're thankful to the Lord and happy to report that over the past two months God has provided several opportunities to share with neighbors. I was able to share with Daigee-suren (our neighbor) and Zorigoo (a 28 year old man who has worked for us in the past).

Zorigoo then came another two times to discuss the Bible and learn more about Jesus. I also had the opportunity to speak with Daigee-suren's son, Munk-bat, and his brother-in-law about God, sin, judgment and eternal life. They all have received some sort of literature or Bible book(s) to read. Pray for them that the words they have heard and read will be effective in bringing about conviction of sin and a desire to know more of the truth.

While we are in the city Barb will continue with homeschooling the children and hopefully will be able to involve the children in a co-op program with other missionary kids once a week. We also look forward to seeing our teammates again when they return in mid-March from their furlough.

Would you also please pray for us as we consider the possibility of working full-time with the BSM after we return from furlough in 2010.
