In mid-May we returned to Mongolia and stayed in the capital for almost a month. During that time we received our yearly living permission, met with a number of missionary friends and worked a little at the Bible Society office. We then took a van ride out to Tosontsengel and got busy settling into our home. We've had a number of minor repairs to do around the yard and house after leaving it empty for nine months. This has been a rainy summer for us, which has been great as the hillsides are a nice green and the crops are all growing well. I took the picture at the top of the page one clear night, without a zoom. It might look like a view from the Hubble but this is our view of God's handiwork; we can often see the milky way!

The children are enjoying their summer break and are now able to help around the house a lot more. They've been getting water from the well with our water cart and helping Mom with making meals. It is exciting to see them grow and mature.

The Mongolians who had been coming to the Sunday worship time during the winter have stopped coming, but God has provided

opportunities to continue to talk and teach them from the Bible at their homes. Among them are three men and their wives who are our summer guards at our one field. Pray that we would have wisdom to know how best to teach and instruct them from the Bible.

During the past months we have continued to think and pray about our future in Mongolia and especially how it might relate to the Mongolian Bible Society. At this point we are considering moving (possibly permanently) to Ulaanbaatar in the spring to help them in more direct ways. This might include helping to finish the Bible so it is all ready for printing, getting vehicles ready for the distribution of the Bible and then organizing the actual distribution throughout Mongolia. Nothing has been firmly decided at this time, and there are many unanswered questions at this point. Would you pray that God's direction would be clear to our family and that we would be attentive to discern His will.
