DEAR FRIENDS,

As I write we have one more week in Ulaanbaatar. Our four months here have gone by quickly. The kids however are anxious to get back to their home in Tosontsengel and to enjoy the summer months in the countryside.

My work at the Bible Society of Mongolia (BSM) went well and was helpful to them. Some of the projects I was involved there were:

- ◆ Ordering and installing some new hardware for their computer network
- ◆ Updating the font I made this past summer
- ◆ Setting up a disk and tape backup system
- ◆ Producing the maps in Mongolian for the back of the Bible
- ◆ Installing and learning the typesetting program that will be used to produce the Bible
- ◆ Helping spell-check the entire text of the Bible

Just recently the first read-through of the Bible was completed, checking for stylistic

consistency. Now a second read-through has begun with three of the BSM workers. It is hoped that the complete Bible will be available within a year's time. Over 70% of the needed funds for printing have been raised so far, and it is exciting to see this very long project (begun in 1973) head down the final stretch.

While in the capital the kids enjoyed attending a homeschool co-op with other MKs. Barb also enjoyed making new friends with many of the mothers while the kids had art and P.E. classes two times a week. As a family, we were blessed to worship at an English language international church each Sunday. We also greatly enjoyed hosting and visiting many missionary families here. These were times of refreshment for each of us. We continue to pray about our future in Mongolia; it may turn out that we become nomadic, working in more than one place.
